What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how GlidePath Age 40 has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the investment option with other funds. Fisher Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this investment option

GlidePath Age 40 is a representation of the GlidePath life cycle. This investment option invests 32% in the Aggressive Fund and 68% in the Growth Fund.

What are the risks of investing?

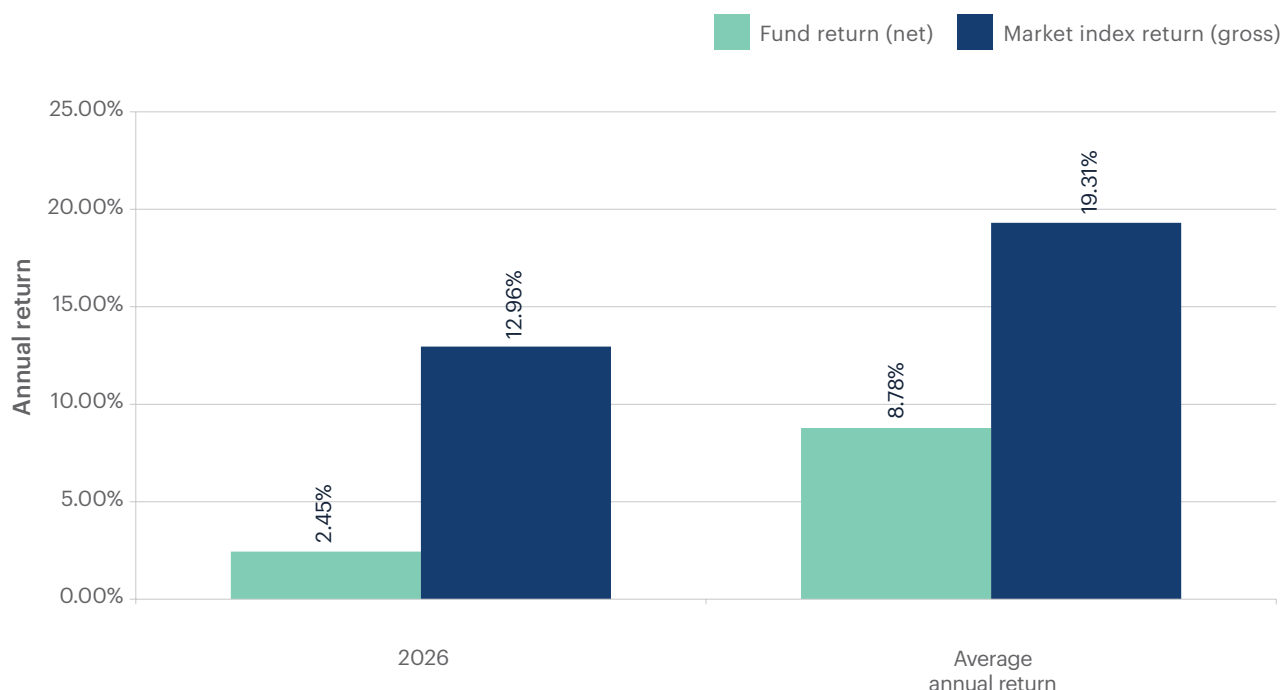
How has the investment option performed?

Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 30 June 2026.

Returns in this update are after tax at the highest prescribed investor rate (PIR) of tax for an individual New Zealand resident. Your tax may be lower. The market index return reflects no deduction for charges and tax.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in GlidePath Age 40 are charged fund charges. Based on the PDS dated 30 September 2025, these are expected to be:

There is no extra charge for GlidePath. The annual fund charges for the underlying fund(s) apply.

In the year to 31 March 2027 we expect the total fund charges to be 1.17%. This is the result of a reasonable estimate of the future other management and administration charges costs based on:

- a combination of forecast expenses and historic expenses charged both to the funds and the underlying funds invested into; and
- expected growth in the net asset value of the funds over time.

The Manager's basic fee is disclosed on a before tax basis. GST has been added to the other management and administration charges (estimate) where applicable.

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.



Example of how this applies to an investor

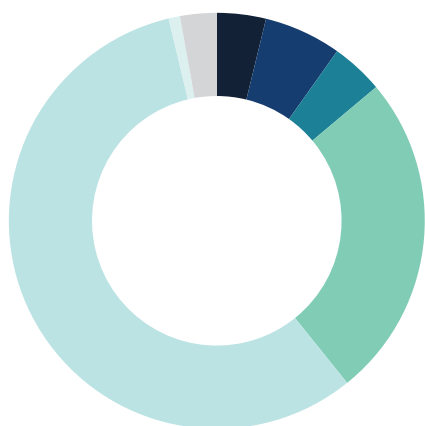
Alice had \$10,000 in the investment option at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Alice received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$603 (that is 6.03% of her initial \$10,000). This gives Alice a total return after tax of \$603 for the year.

Actual investment mix

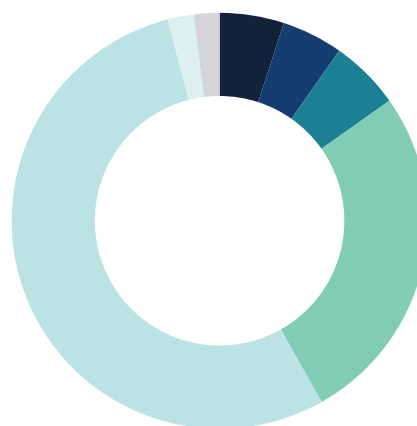
This shows the types of assets that the investment option invests in.
